| <u>Species</u> | <u>Where Seen</u> |

| Pied-billed Grebe | Diving in both ponds. |
| Double-crested Cormorant | Catching sunfish/upper pond. Perched in sun/lower pond. |
| Green Heron | On shore, both ponds. In flight. |
| Mallard | On lower pond. |
| Cooper's Hawk | Perched on fence post. |
| Sharp-shinned Hawk | At parking lot, carrying ground squirrel. |
| Red-tailed hawk | In flight across park. |
| American Kestrel | On power pole . In flight carrying small rodent. |
| Gambel's Quail. | On embankment above foot-bridge. |
| American Coot | On both ponds. |
| Killdeer | Heard by river, but not seen. |
| Rock Dove | Various flocks in flight, parking lot and around Central St. bridge. |
| Mourning Dove | On ground alongside west end of main path. |
| Anna's Hummingbird | Males. One alongside main trail, one across from foot-bridge. |
| Black Phoebe | In trees by stream near foot-bridge. |
| Verdin | Mostly heard. Pair in tree alongside return trail below fence & buildings |
| Orange-crowned Warbler | In reeds at river. In scrub below path under old bridge pillars.Hard to see. |
| Yellow-rumped Warbler (Audubon's) | In trees below path near foot-bridge. Very fast and hard to see. |
| Abert's Towhee | Alongside path to river. |
| Song Sparrow | Called out in scrub below path under old bridge pillars. Brief look. |
| White-crowned Sparrow. | Only one, seen briefly in tree by path to river. |
| House Finch | Various. Sun location provided excellent views. |
